A guide to Understanding Tenant Reports:

- Executive Summary: The Executive Summary provides you with information on the status of every search type included in your report and highlights any searches that are flagged for your review. For example: if you take the Executive Summary below and we itemize it out.
- Credit Is complete with no Flags.
- County Criminal Record Search Review Something appeared that requires an assessment.
- Advanced Locator Review Something appeared that requires an assessment.
- Advanced Eviction Locator Review Something appeared that requires an assessment.
- Oregon Eviction Is complete with no Flags.
- Rental Verification Is complete with no Flags.
- **Report Decisions:** Your account now includes the Report Decision tool. The Decision Dot has been added to help provide efficient communication with your internal process and streamline and document your rental decision workflow.

Insight Reporting will only set a report to Approved (no flags) or Review (flags). Anything beyond that such as Conditional, Individual Assessment, or Denial will be set by your team after reviewing the report. Even in the case of no flags on the report, you should view the contents of the report to ensure it meets your criteria.
