### A Summary of Your Rights Under the Fair Credit Reporting Act

redeal Fair Credit Esporting Act (FCRA) premotes the accuracy, farmers, and privacy of information in the files of resporting agencies. - You have the right to know what is in your file. You may request and obtain all the information about you in the files of a consumer reporting agency (your "file disclosure"). You will be required to provide proper identification, which must include your Social Security number. In many cases, the disclosure will be fire. You are entitled to a free file disclosure.

In addition, all consumers are entitled to one free disclosure every 12 months upon request from each nationwide credit bureau and from nationwide specialty consumer reporting agencies. See <a href="https://www.consumerfinance.gov/learminore.gov/

- You have the right to ask for a credit score. Credit scores are numerical summaries of your credit-worthiness based on information from credit bureaus. You may request a credit score from consumer reporting agencies that create scores or distribute accores acred in residential real property losses, but you will have to pay for it. In some mortgage tunnactions, you will receive even that create scores or the mortgage tender.
- You have the right to dispute incomplete or inaccurate information. If you stentify information in your file that is incomplete or inaccurate, and report it to the consumer reporting agency, the agency must investigate unless your dispute in fivolous. See invivocommentalizance gover inseringer for an explanation of dispute procedures.
- Consumer reporting agencies must correct or delete inaccurate, incomplete, or unverifiable information.

  Inaccurate, incomplete, or unverifiable information must be removed or corrected, usually within 30 days. However, a
  consumer reporting agency may continue to report information it has verified as accurate.
- Consumer reporting agencies may not report outdated negative information. In most cases, a consumer reporting agency may not report negative information that is more than seven years old, or bankruptcies that are more than 10 man old.
- Access to your file is limited. A consumer reporting agency may provide information about you only to people with a valid need—usually to consider an application with a creditor, insurer, employer, landlord, or other business. The FCRA aspectives those with a valid need for access.
- You must give your consent for reports to be provided to employers. A comment reporting agency may not give out information about you to your employer, or a potential employer, without your written consent given to the employer.
